There are two issues we will be looking at today.

The Coming Kingdom and Spiritual Warfare

There are two sides to the world we live in a physical and a spiritual. (2 Kings 6:15-19)

When words are repeated in scripture there is a level of importance placed on them; especially those spoken by Jesus.

We will be looking at a phrase found in the second and third chapters of Revelation that is repeated seven times. (Rev. 2:2; 2:9; 2:13; 2:19; 3:1; 3:8; 3:15)

"I know your deeds / works" (NIV/NASB)

Jesus sees all, (Luke 21: 1-4)

Jesus is preparing His disciples and ultimately us so we will not be deceived. (Matt. 24: 4-8)

"Because of the increase of wickedness, the love of most will grow cold, but he who stands firm to the end will be saved."

No one knows the day or hour Jesus will return. (Matt. 24:36-44)
